

2.3 Self-review

Statement of Intent

The board of Onslow College regularly reviews the school's operations to ensure that the school is in line with legislation and other government requirements, as well as with the directions set by the school's charter.

Board Expectations

The Board's expectations regarding self review are that:

- a self-review cycle will be established and followed
- self-review will include matters directly related to student achievement and curriculum, as well as other areas of the school's operation which support student achievement
- review of curriculum areas and all related matters will be led by the principal
- review of other areas of the boards operation will be led by other board members and will involve consultation with management
- self-review will be directed towards answering questions agreed in advance by the board (see guidelines for self-review)
- to the greatest extent possible self-review will draw on existing review processes and data.
- terms of reference will be developed for each non-curriculum self-review

Supporting Documents

The board expects that the following documents outlining management policies, procedures or practices are in the school. Where they have been developed by the school they will be regularly reviewed by management. These documents are available to the board:

- the self-review cycle
- guidelines for board self-review
