ADDITIONAL FEES

Item	Cost
Dietary requirements	If a student has a special dietary requirement, supplementary food costs of \$50p/w apply. Dietary requirements can be vegan, vegetarian, keto or life threatening food allergies that require the host family to purchase extra to cater for the student's diet.
Storage Fee	Returning students who leave over the summer break will be charged a storage fee of \$50 p/w up to a maximum of 8 weeks or \$400.
Airport services	If airport transfers before 7:00am or after 11:00pm are required, a \$150 charge is applied. Otherwise it will be \$60 each way.
Stationery and workbooks	Many subjects attract additional fees for materials, e.g. photography, art, field trips and workbooks. These costs are course dependent and will vary based on subject selection.
Sports and extracurricular	These costs vary and depend on the activities and sports that students decide to engage in.
School Trips	Activities (or Trips) outside school such as Parliament, Te Papa Museum, overnight camps, etc may incur additional costs.
Document Authentication	Inclusive of notarisation and Apostille - \$150.

Students should allow for the following expenses where appropriate. Costs are indicative only and will vary based on the individualised course selection.

Equipment

Onslow College is a Google Workspace school providing all students with access to email, productivity tools and fit for purpose learning tools. Students will require either a laptop, iPad/ Tablet [with keyboard] for all subjects. Mathematics courses may require a scientific or graphic calculator.
